1. Domestic Shelters

2. Red Rover

The Red Rover Relief Safe Escape grant program helps families with pets safely escape domestic violence together. Funding is mainly provided to help with the cost of up to 45 days of pet boarding while a survivor is in a domestic violence shelter, though other costs associated with boarding like vaccinations can be considered. Assistance does not typically cover pet boarding once the survivor has moved from the safe house into transitional housing.
